

Forklift injuries, on average, cause an injured worker to be away from work for 17 days - compared to 12 days for other workplace

accidents.

- More than 7,700 workers experienced injuries from forklift accidents in one recent year. • Manufacturing, transportation and warehousing, and wholesale trade are the three sectors that report the highest rate of forklift
- The most common type of forklift accident is transportation incident with 52% of reported accidents.







It has a hearty texture and sweet, home-baked flavor, but none of the fat and calories. **Ingredients** • 3 cups all-purpose flour • 1-1/2 cups sugar 1 teaspoon baking powder 1 teaspoon salt 1 teaspoon baking soda 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon Two large eggs, room temperature

One teaspoon of vanilla extract • 3 cups chopped peeled tart apples **Toppings**

• Two tablespoons chopped walnuts

• 1/2 cup all-purpose flour

1/2 cup sugar

Instructions:

• 1/3 cup cold butter

• 1/2 cup unsweetened applesauce

• 1/3 cup canola oil
